We currently serve over 150 children in full-time and part-time programs and also offer an after school program for elementary children and a summer camp. Our programs are open to and are utilized by families of all backgrounds in the southwest Austin community.

At the Children’s Center we dare to see children as unique individuals with a variety of gifts and abilities, rather than expecting them to all act and perform the same. As a reflection of that, our teaching philosophy involves recognizing those gifts and taking the limits off children’s learning and abilities. We believe that children have unlimited potential, and every interaction is a chance to nudge forward a child’s development or learning.
